MAHARASHTRA PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT 1999

- o Ragging is strictly prohibited as per Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999.
- o Ragging entails heavy fines and/or imprisonment.
- o Ragging invokes suspension and dismissal from the college and university.
- o Outsiders are prohibited from entering the college premises without prior permission.
- o All the students must carry their identity cards and show them when demanded.

Anti – Ragging Cell

The college received UGC letter D.O.NO. F.1-15 / 2009 / (ARC) pt-III dated 17th July , 2015 on 24th July 2015 with an intention to curb the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions. The college immediately took an action considering the urgency of the letter. A meeting of all the teachers was called on 25th July 2015 under the chairpersonship of Principal Dr. Priya Wanjari . All faculty felt the immediate need to constitute an Anti-ragging committee. Accordingly Anti-ragging committee was established.

3. To fill in the declaration form from students for not indulging in ragging
