MINUTES OF MEETING OF IQAC HELD ON 25th JUNE, 2022

The meeting of IQAC was held on 25th June, 2022 under the chairmanship of the Principal in the Seminar Hall at 2:30pm. Following office bearers remained present in the meeting. At the outset Dr. Priya Wanjari, Principal and Chairperson, IQAC welcomed all the members. Dr. Neehal R. Sheikh, IQAC Coordinator also extended welcome to all and read out the agenda of the meeting. Following points of the agenda were discussed and decisions taken –

- Presentation of Minutes of the previous meeting –
 The minutes of the previous meeting were read out and approval by all the present office bearers.
- 2. To review the policies and programs implemented during the session The IQAC took review of the policies and programs as finalized in the meeting held on 19-07-2021. Dr. Neehal R. Sheikh briefed that online and offline modes of teaching were practiced as and when directions were issued by the University and administration. Mr. Dinesh Wanjari said that as holding of offline classes is being permitted, students should be prepared for University Examination in a rigorous manner. He added that activities based on syllabus should be designed.
- 3. Installation of Fire Extinguishers and boards The members of the IQAC personally visited and confirmed that the fire extinguishers and boards were installed at appropriate places. The members were satisfied with the boards installed at all important places. Dr. Shamrao Koreti said that the places where fire extinguishers have been installed must be easily accessible. He said that more number of staff members must be trained to handle the equipments to avoid any casualty.
- 4. Highlighting the Achievements of the Alumni and Faculty –
 It was informed that in Deeksharamb Student Induction Program held through online mode Mr. Nitin Bangade, a proud alumni of the college was invited to motivate the students. The college highlighted the achievements of the alumni association members. Dr. Sudha Ramachandra was facilitated for her research paper being selected by the World Health Organization. Mr. Krishna Sawade said that the details of Research papers published by the faculty members should be displayed on the college website.

5. Enrollment of more number of Research Scholars -

Dr. Neehal R. Sheikh mentioned that as per the notification issued by the university the process of enrollment of research scholars in English and Commerce was initiated. Dr. Priya Wanjari pointed out that the meeting of Research Advisory Committee was called and all the Research Scholars made their presentations and all the required changed were incorporated into the synopsis and submitted to the University for further process. She mentioned that 5 Research scholars were registered in English, 6 in Commerce and 1 in Business Economics during the session. Dr. Urmila Dabir raised question about the validity of the Place of Higher Learning and Research. Dr. Priya Wanjari briefed the members that the Place of Higher Learning and Research approved by the university has been renewed and the validity has been sanctioned for further five years. Mrs. Archana Vaidya said that if teachers have been recognized as Research Supervisory, then they must have research scholars under their supervision as per the permissible number.

6. Research Funds for Social Responsibilities -

The IQAC was informed that a proposal for National Level Seminar sponsored by ICSSR will be prepared and submitted. Dr. Priya Wanjari said that the theme will be chosen on a social issue in lines with the 75 years of independence.

7. Student-oriented and student-centric activities -

Dr. Neehal R. Sheikh added that in addition to the prescribed curriculum, Career Oriented Certificate Course were run in Human Rights, Rural Development, Local History of Nagpur, Cyber Security, Herbal Plants and Stress Management. Dr. Priya Wanjari said that these courses had novelty and very beneficial to the students from the point of view of their career. Mr. Jagdish Watmode mentioned that 6 Career Oriented Certificate Courses were approved by Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension. She also informed that a National Online Certificate Course in Shakespeare Studies was organized in association with three other colleges and Shakespeare Society of Central India. Dr. Neehal R. Sheikh said that every year a certificate course on Garment Manufacturing approved by Maharashtra State Board in implemented to sharpen the employability skills of the students. Mr. Vijay Kandalkar and Dr. Sunil Ramteke said that new kinds of student centric activities should be evolved to retain the interest of the students in academics.

8. Academic and other activities –

Dr. Priya Wanjari said that many activities of different nature have been organized by the institution. She added that need based activities have been designed and programs have been designed accordingly. Dr. Neehal R. Sheikh said that a National Level Faculty Development-cum-Orientation Program on 'Assessment and Accreditation Process of NAAC was held through online mode from 20th to 27th September, 2021. Mrs. Mrudula Kharkate said that

seminars and webinars have been organized at national and international platform and this trend must continue.

9. Any other matter with the permission of the Chairperson – Shri Ram Wanjari enquired about the status of the Self Study Report to be submitted for the 4th Cycle of Assessment and Accreditation by NAAC. Dr. Priya Wanjari informed that the IIQA has been submitted and accepted by NAAC and the college is determined to submit the Self Study Report till 25th July, 2022.

As there was no other point for discussion, the meeting ended with a formal vote of thanks.

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Minutes of the meeting of IQAC held on 30th August, 2022

The meeting of Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the college was held on 30th August, 2022 at 12.30 pm under the chairmanship of the Principal in the Seminar Hall. Dr. Neehal R. Sheikh, IQAC Coordinator extended welcome to all the office bearers. Discussion took place on following points of the agenda and decisions taken-

- 1. To confirm the minutes of the previous meeting-
- The minutes of the previous meeting was read out. The office bearers granted approval to the minutes.
- 2. Action Taken Report of previous IQAC Meeting-
- Dr. Neehal R. Sheikh and concerning teachers briefed the IQAC about the following Action Taken Report based on the discussions taken place in the last meeting-
- a. Extra classes were arranged for those students whose university examination classes were to be held. Students were trained through different methods and rigorous training was imparted on Multiple Choice Questions.
- b. More staff members of the non teaching staff have been trained on how to use fire extinguisher devices.
- c. List of research papers published in reputed journals, books and chapters published in books have been made available on college website
- d. The Ph. D supervisors will fill up the vacant seats according to the schedule of registration for Ph. D prepared by the University.
- e. The proposal for organization of a National Seminar by ICSSR is being prepared by teachers of Department of English and Social Sciences.
- f. Activity based teaching was introduced by some of the teachers.
- g. College teachers have been asked to make preparations for organization of academic activities like Seminars, Webinars and Conferences.
- h. The college is making all possible efforts to answer the queries raised by NAAC in the DVV. The members expressed satisfaction over the Action Taken Report.

3. To prepare Plan of action for academic session 2022-23-

The members made suggestions and following Plan of Action has been prepared for the academic session 2022-23

- a. To organize ICSSR sponsored National level Seminar, if proposal sanctioned.
- b. To organize Workshops on need based topics
- c. To hold Collaborative Activities on creativity and novel ideas.
- d. To conduct Online surveys for quality enhancement.
- e. Holding of training camps or sessions to boost employability.
- f. Organization of Placement Drives.
- g. Timely submission of AQAR of 2021-22
- 4. To take review of the preparations for assessment by NAAC-

Mr. Krishna Sawade asked the concerning teachers and members of the non teaching staff to brief the IQAC about the preparations they have made for submission of responses as have been asked to submit in the DVV. Dr. Shrikant Pajankar informed that the college has formed teams according to the criterion and the team leaders gave information about the kind of preparation they have been making. Dr. Urmila Dabir asked all the team leaders and IQAC Coordinator to stick to the Standard Operating Procedure for Data Validation and Verification of Affiliated PG Colleges for HEIs prescribed by NAAC. Mrs. Archana Bhoyar and Dr. Shamrao I Koreti asked all the HoDs to give a brief presentation of the activities held. Dr. Urmila Dabir said that an add-on report should also be prepared to inform the Peer Team Members of the kind of activities held after the submission of the SSR.

- 5. To take review of the preparations for submission of AQAR of Academic Session 2021-21-Mrs. Mrudula Kharkate mentioned that as the format of AQAR has changed, a minute study should be made and answers must be framed according to the programmes and policies implemented. Ms. Gayatri Katare volunteered to contribute in collecting all student related data and information.
- 6. To suggest measures for quality improvement- Mr. Vijay Kandalkar suggested that more number of MoUs should be signed so that expertise can be made available from professional bodies and organizations. Mr. Jagdish Watmode suggested that teachers should be encouraged to prepare add-on courses which are interdisciplinary in nature as has been highlighted in the National Education Policy- 2020. Dr. Sunil Ramteke said that all teachers should be trained thoroughly in use of latest ICT based teaching techniques. Shri Dinesh Wanjari said that though the teachers are acquainted with the use of ICT yet one must admit that technology keeps changing and the teachers must be equipped with the latest techniques and a training programme can be organized to provide this kind of a training.

7. Any other matter with the permission of the chairperson- Mr. Ram Wanjari said that all the teachers must get thoroughly involved in making an effective preparation for the assessment and accreditation by NAAC.

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Minutes of the Meeting of IQAC held on 31st December, 2022

The meeting of the IQAC was held at the IQAC office on 31st December, 2022 at 12:30pm under the chairmanship of Dr. Priya Wanjari, Principal and Chairperson, IQAC. Dr. Priya Wanjari extended a hearty welcome to all the members and requested them to actively participate in the deliberations and make effective suggestions and recommendations as the Peer Team Visit has been scheduled on 4th and 5th January, 2023. The proceedings of the meeting took place in the following manner –

- To confirm the minutes of the previous meeting –
 Dr. Neehal R. Sheikh, IQAC Coordinator and Member Secretary, read out the minutes of the previous meeting. The minutes were accepted and approved by all the members.
- 2. Action Taken Report of the previous IQAC meeting
 - Dr. Neehal R. Sheikh and concerning teachers briefed the IQAC about the action taken on the resolutions and decisions taken place in the previous meeting in the following manner –
- a. Dr. Shrikant M. Mr. Vaibhav Dandekar said that industry academia interaction activity must be held in order to assess the kind of manpower needed in industries in present era.
- 4. To take review of preparations for Assessment by NAAC Dr. Priya Wanjari assured all the members of the IQAC that effective preparations have been made by all the teachers and in-charge of activities/cells/committees and the process of documentation has been verified. 3. To Take Review of the Assessment and Accreditation by NAAC-

The IQAC took stock of the way the in which the assessment and accreditation process was completed by NAAC. Dr. Shrikant Pajankar said that the all the members of the teaching and non-teaching staff worked very hard but there is a need to change the style of functioning according to the prescribed guidelines of the NAAC in order to secure a better grade in future. Dr. Priya Wanjari mentioned that many relevant activities were held, inspite of the hardships being faced due to Covid-19 and the subsequent lockdown and more importantly the academic session of 2021-22 was excluded in the assessment period. Mr. Vaibhav Dandekar said that more number of collaborative and research based activities need to be introduced for the sake of quality improvement. The IQAC accepted the suggestions.

4. To take review preparation regarding introduction of NEP-2020

Dr. Priya Wanjari informed the IQAC that all the teachers are gearing up and making earnest efforts to mould the pedagogy to meet the expectations as laid down in National Education Policy-2020. Mr. Jagdish Watmode said that all the teachers must go through the National Education Policy-2020 document prepared by the Ministry of Human, Resource Development, Government of India and pay attention to the fact that it lays particular emphasis on the development of the creative potential of each individual. Mr. Yash Wanjari said that the college should also concentrate on opening of Academic Bank of Credits by all the students in the new academic session. Mr. Rajesh Ashtankar said that the students of 12th Class of the college should also be briefed about the expected changes to be brought into existence when NEP-2020 will be implemented from their First Year of Under Graduation.

5. Presentation about activities-

The Faculty-in-charge briefed the IQAC about the academic and extension activities organized during the session. Dr. Shrikant Sontakke informed that the Department of Social Sciences has successfully organized the National Seminar on 'Socio-cultural, Economic and Literary Transformation during 75 years of India's Independence' held on 7th January, 2023.
